
Medicaid EHR Incentive Program Dashboard

The purpose of the Medicaid EHR Incentive Program is to provide incentive payments to certain health care professionals and hospitals that meet specific eligibility requirements when they adopt, implement, upgrade and meaningfully use CMS-certified EHR technology. EHRs have been proven to promote improved care coordination and lower costs.

Eligible Professionals



\$956,250



Forty-five (45) eligible professionals (EP) received payments of \$21,250 each in Program Year 2013* for adopting, implementing or upgrading (AIU) to an Electronic Health Record system. Aggregate EP payments = \$956,250.

Eligible Hospitals



\$12.6M




Five (5) Eligible Hospitals received a total of \$12.6 million in payments for Program Year 2013.

62% of District physicians e-prescribe



Electronic prescribing (e-prescribing) is quickly becoming common practice in the modern U.S. health care system. By 2012, more than 90 percent of community pharmacies had the capability to and were actively e-prescribing. Health care professionals can e-prescribe via electronic health records (EHRs) or standalone e-prescribing systems.

STEPS TO MEET MEANINGFUL USE

1. Adopt, Implement or Upgrade to a CMS-certified EHR
2. Register for the Medicaid EHR Program with CMS
3. Attest via the District's Medicaid EHR portal <http://dc.arringincentive.com/>
4. Adopt and Practice Meaningful Use standards
