SUBJECT: DC Medicaid requires referring provider number on DME/POS claims

Section 6401(b)(ii)(7)(A),(B) of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (i.e. Health Care Reform) requires that the NPI for any ordering or referring provider must be shown on any claim for payment that is based on an order or referral. Durable medical equipment (DME) and Prosthetics, Orthotics and Medical Supplies (POS), as a category of health care services, has been identified by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid as subject to this new regulation. Having this information readily available in claims data will assist not only with any investigations and trending for potential fraud, but can and will be utilized for quality assurance within the DME program itself. Therefore, it is imperative that we have the mechanism in place with which to collect this claim information.

Beginning with dates of service October 1, 2012, the Department of Healthcare Finance (DHCF) will require all DME/POS Claims include the name and NPI of the physician/ARNP prescribing the Durable Medical equipment or supplies. DME/POS providers should record and submit the prescribing physician/ARNP in the following manner:

- UB04 Name entered in Field 17, NPI entered in Field 17B
- 837 P Name entered in Loop 2310A NM107 segment & NPI entered in in Loop 2310A NM109 segment with qualifier XX in segment NM108.
- Web Portal Answer **yes** to the question: *is this service as a result of a referral?* Enter the NPI in the field referring provider and the name in the additional referring provider information.
- WinAsap In the drop down box for Reference Provider enter the NPI, Name, and Address. Click Save. Answer **no** to the question: *is this provider intended for Billing or Pay-To Plan provider?* Select the appropriate provider in the Referring Provider 1 drop down box in the professional claim data screen.
