SUBJECT: *Services My Way* program Enrollment Announcement

This transmittal notifies the public that the Department of Health Care Finance (DHCF) is enrolling eligible §1915 (c) Elderly and Persons with Physical Disabilities (EPD) waiver beneficiaries into the Participant-directed Services (PDS) program known as *Services My Way* as of March 28, 2016.

The *Services My Way* program will allow EPD waiver beneficiaries that live in their natural home the ability to exercise more choice and control of their Medicaid Long Term Care services. Participants enrolled in the *Services My Way* program will have the option to self-direct two (2) specific EPD waiver services: Participant-directed Community Supports and Individual Directed Goods and Services.

Enrollment Process

Beneficiaries that are interested in enrolling in the *Services My Way* program should contact their case manager to obtain additional information. The case manager will work with the beneficiary to complete or update the Person-Centered Plan (PCP) to include *Services My Way*. Beneficiaries will then be contacted by a Support Broker from Consumer Direct DC for a comprehensive orientation and training of program requirements. The Support Broker will also assist in completing all required enrollment forms and agreements. The beneficiary will be notified in writing when all forms and agreements have been approved and they can begin accessing services in the *Services My Way* program.
