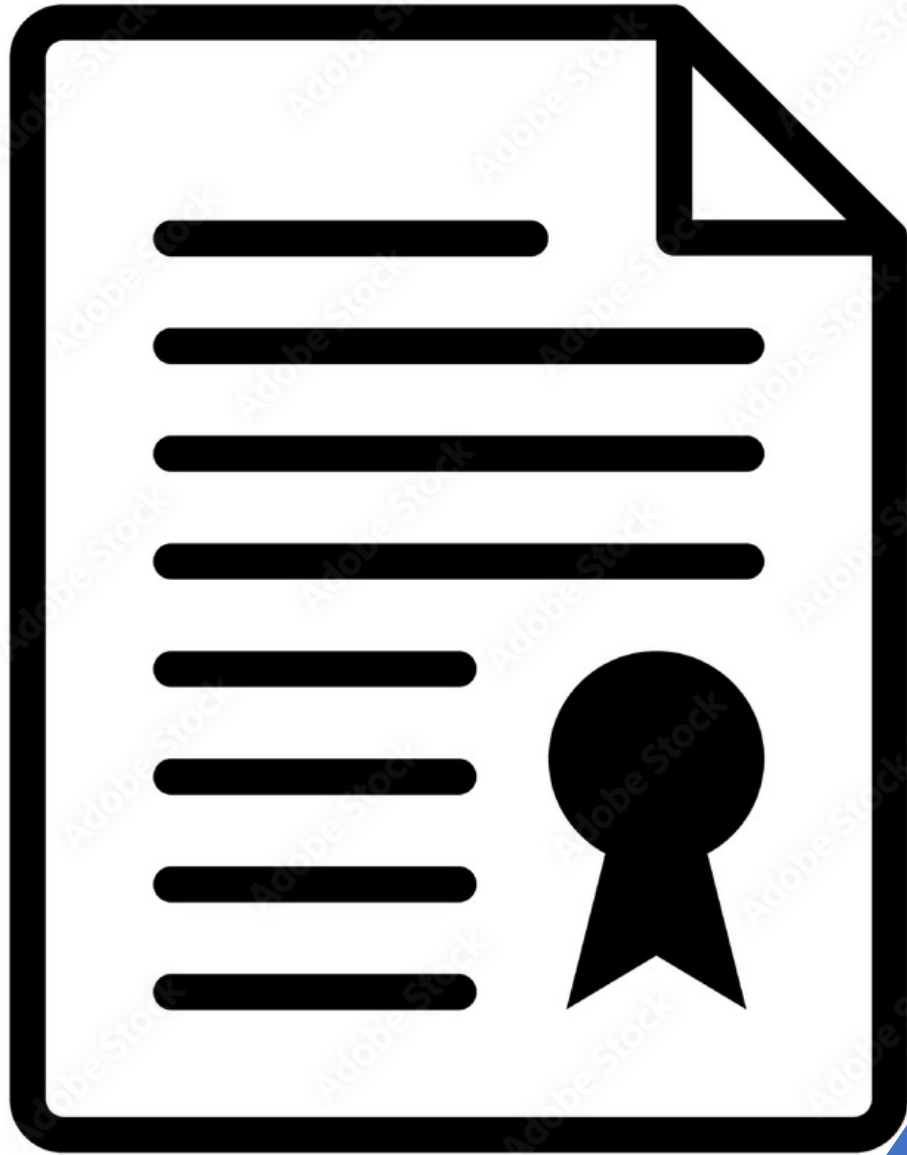

UPDATE

Medicaid Managed Care Contracts Will Be Implemented Effective April 1, 2023

- New contracts have been awarded to: Amerigroup, Amerihealth Caritas DC, and MedStar Family Choice DC
- Led by DHCF, readiness period is underway for the April 1, 2023, start date
 - Systems testing
 - Provider credentialing
 - Data sharing
- Medicaid managed care members will be notified of program changes in March
- Continuity of care / transition period is 90 days or from April 1 – June 30

Standardized Tools: Prior Authorizations & Performance Evaluation

DLA 20

The Daily Living Activities-20 (DLA-20) is an adult functional assessment tool which DBH plans to implement beginning on March 1, 2023. The DLA-20 is designed to assess what daily living areas are impacted by mental illness or disability.

CAFAS/PECFAS

The Child & Adolescent Functional Assessment Scale (“CAFAS”) and the Pre-school & Early Childhood Functional Assessment Scale (“PECFAS”) are rating scales which assess functional impairment attributed to behavioral, emotional, psychological, or substance use disorders in youth ages 3-20.
