SUBJECT: Eleventh COVID Update for Long Term Care Providers

News since our last bulletin:

• The LTCA Billing and Documentation Guidance document has been revised and is attached here for your reference. In these updates, DHCF is clarifying providers' obligations to effectively document services delivered remotely. These updates conform to guidance issued by DHCF to providers of other remote services (e.g., telemedicine) via Transmittal #20-42.
