SUBJECT: Program Year 2019 of the DC Medicaid EHR Incentive Program will open

on January 6, 2020 and will close on March 31, 2020

The purpose of this transmittal is to announce the opening of Program Year 2019 for the DC Medicaid EHR Incentive/Promoting Interoperability Program on January 6, 2020. The Department of Health Care Finance (DHCF) will accept attestations from all eligible providers from now until the close of the program year on March 31, 2020.

To qualify for 2019 Medicaid EHR incentive payments of \$8,500 per program year, a provider must:

- Be either a licensed physician, nurse practitioner, certified nurse midwife or dentist;
- Maintain a Medicaid patient volume threshold of 30% (20% for pediatricians); and
- Have already received a Medicaid EHR incentive payment from DC or another state

DHCF is partnering with eHealthDC to offer <u>free technical assistance</u> to all eligible providers this year and through the end of the program in 2021. eHealthDC offers support to providers who require assistance to meet the requirements of the incentive program and navigate the new state-level registry (SLR) system to apply for the incentive payment.

eHealthDC is also available to help providers attest for Program Year 2019. If you would like assistance with program year 2019, please contact eHealthDC immediately to receive assistance prior to the March 31, 2020 deadline.
