SUBJECT: Medicaid Fee Schedule Updates to the Reimbursement Rates for District

ICF/IID.

The purpose of this Transmittal is to inform operators of ICFs/IID of the Medicaid reimbursement changes. The Department of Health Care Finance (DHCF), in accordance with the requirements set forth in 29 DCMR §§ 988.4 and 4102.7(i), announces changes to the current enhanced reimbursement rates for District ICF/IID to reflect the increase in the Living Wage to \$17.50. The changes to the rates will become effective July 1, 2024.

The ICF/IID reimbursement rates are adjusted to reflect the changes to the Living Wage Act of 2006, effective June 8, 2006 (D.C. Law 16-118; D.C. Official Code 2-220.01 et seq. (2012 Repl.).

In addition, the DSP wage component includes the assumption of the enhanced DSP wage of an average of 117.6% to ensure adherence to DC Law 23-77, Direct Support Professional Payment Rate Act of 2020.
