Welcome to CRISP DC's interactive resource on health information exchange adoption and use.

As the District of Columbia's Designated HIE Entity since early 2020, CRISP DC is the DC Department of Health Care Finance's (DHCF) organizational partner for providing citywide HIE services. CRISP DC is committed to supporting the development and maintenance of HIE services in order to facilitate the secure, electronic exchange of health information among the District Registered HIE entities and participating organizations in the District.

As the District's Designated HIE Entity, CRISP DC developed this interactive resource in partnership with DHCF to incrementally track progress of District-wide HIE adoption and use. This resource is intended to give the user the ability to view performance metrics, including the number of providers who are utilizing CRISP throughout the District and the total number of organizations contributing data to CRISP over time.

CRISP Shared Services increases DC Representation in HIE Technology and Operations Governance

 CRISP DC shares HIE technology with CRISP Maryland and West Virginia Health Information Network. This creates important economies of scale – allowing us to implement more technology at lower cost.

- Through the non-profit "CRISP Shared Services" HIE assets are formally governed by representatives from all three regions
- CRISP DC's interests are represented on the board of CRISP Shared Services and other committees by members of the DC healthcare community as determined by the CRISP DC Board of Directors.

- CRISP DC has partnered with DC based company nClud to improve our web presence
- We have kicked off the project and are hoping to have a new website ready over the next several months
- We are putting a heavy focus on easy and understandable access to our policies and procedures
- We are also engaged in better SEO (search engine optimization) so that a Google Search for CRISP DC brings our new page to the top

The team continues to work virtually without disruption






Notable Use Case Implementations

- SDOH Referral Pilot
 - Provider facing access to send a patient referral to a community benefit organization
- Support for MCOs during transition





The Referrals tab opens with patient demographic information prepopulated

CORIE's goal is to allow providers and CBOs to make referrals in the systems they use every day

If an organization does not have access to such a system they can use the CRISP ULP to make and receive referrals

Referral routing will also be available into existing SDOH systems like Aunt Bertha
